PRINCIPAL'S CORNER:

- 1. Fundraiser Concerns: Concerned parents have come forward with strong displeasure re: AG fundraising tiers. Goal for board and administration is to look at issues objectively given our school has many different POVs. Changes will be made and implemented over the next few weeks. Priority evaluation will be on:
 - AG tiers should not have priority seating at school wide events (Winter Show and 5th grade graduation) and pledges should not receive banners with certain \$ amount given.
 - Parents have expressed how upset they are and have made threats to file complaints with district.
 - Current amount of people who will be affected by a reversal of the incentive is the 15 families who have already pledged this year and 4 tickets that were sold through our last Gala
 - Solution for now- we are going to take out priority seating and freeze our \$50k surplus.
 - Hopefully parents are understanding messaging about importance of fundraising strategy. LAUSD eliminated P.E, Science, Art etc. and therefore, if we want to keep the parents have to fund salaries, so our children can benefit. Everyone needs to understand ramifications if we do not continue to raise these funds.
 - Added instructional time for science, 4th and 5th grade, salary increases yearly, increases on art prep time, increased tech 1-1 chrome books (3-5th), tech for k-2

- 2. Back to School. We've received some complaints about our beginning of school orientation meetings.

 Parents upset there was a push for fundraising and should have been more about meeting teachers/staff.
 - We can address/modify for next year. Challenge is this is the only time parents actually attend meetings. Need to find a better balance to communicate critical info but focus more on school administration.

3. Room 23 (Art Room)/New Kinder Classroom

- Converted to 4th kinder classroom due to increased enrollment. So many neighborhood families, we weren't able to accept ANY lottery kids this year.
- Conducted 33 home checks so far, 3 were not in our school zone. Checks will continue thru year.
- District provided pool kindergarten teacher (Ms. Alvarez) for start of school but she left abruptly at end of day (8/16) due to another job opportunity. Has caused some turmoil.
- Ms. Chun found solution with Andrea Shwimmer from our sub list. She will stay as long as we need her to until proper interviewing is done. Ms. Chun is accepting resumes for fully credentialed teacher.
- Ms. Yvonne converted to a mobile art teacher. Teachers are working with her to ensure we keep a robust art program and provide flexibility & space IN their classrooms.
- Soaring Eagles will now be using auditorium for morning drop-off only

4. Communication

- Continue to streamline ALL communication; Alex to present solution options including capabilities and costs at next meeting. (Remind App, Private FB groups, PTO Today etc...)
- Blackboard is an option via Ms. Chun
