Ned Show- Kind Campaign

Our school-wide character education program centers around a 45 minute assembly called The NED Show. NED is a loveable cartoon character whose name is an acronym for Never give up, Encourage others, and Do your best. Teachers love that NED is simple, relatable and kid-focused.

- Schools have 2 options.

 - Through the Pay-It-Forward payment option your school receives this \$1200 assembly at no cost. When you exceed \$1200 in sales, 10% of the entire proceeds will be awarded to your school in the form of a GIFT CERTIFICATE for charactermessaged NED items—great for student rewards and incentives.
 - Sale runs for 5 days following the show (30 minutes a day) Cannot be during school hours.
 - No minimum sale requirement!
 - We pay return shipping on all unsold product!
 - We provide you with tips and a checklist on how to run a smooth & efficient sale.
 - Can we sell online instead of getting parent volunteers?
 - Cannot be during school hours.
 - Before or After school (15 min each time for total of 30 min)

2. TREASURER

 - Bio: Geraldine is a parent of a 1st grader. Daughter Issa in Ms. Bloom's class. Experience in political and event planning. She is also on Governance Charter board. She has agreed

to be Co-Treasurer for the remainder of the 2017-2019 term. She is helping to plan the 1st International event at Encino for next year 2018-2019.

3. TALENT SHOW WILL BE HELD IN MAY

- Mrs. Perez has agreed to come back from retirement, and will donate her time to conduct tryouts, manage rehearsals and produce the show.
- New process was implemented this year to help parents & students with the process and to combat the negative outcome from last year. To that end, a mandatory Parent meeting that was held on 1/30/18 and info was handed out as follows:

- Gala Goal is \$50K between actual event, auction and Raise the Paddle.
 - We need to determine what we will vote on during the Raise the Paddle programs. Have to make sure parents understand some of these are one time costs vs. a RECURRING annual increase in our overall Fundraising budget. Options include:
 - i. AUDITORIUM SOUND AND LIGHTING: \$28K 50K estimate to upgrade

- ii. (outdoor PA audio system upgrade) how would we go about getting estimate for PA system? LAUSD verified? Or outside source? Keep PA system as separate funding idea-not to be included with auditorium estimate.
- iii. Play structure shades. Have to be done by LAUSD quote is \$100k. Sadly, LAUSD quotes are always 60-70% higher.
- iv. Auditorium upgrade: Eventbrite software for Reserve seating?
- v. Counselor PSW Wellness coaches at schools/School Psychologist. Social emotional issues they work with students and families. Cost is approx \$20k per year for 1-day week. \$42k for 2 days.
- vi. Play Works. Non-profit program that focuses on building positive play/role modeling during recess and lunch time windows. The program helps build character and addresses bullying, negative play patterns and peer pressure.
 - 1. Cost is \$75k for year including the program plus staff to implement in.
 - 2. \$25k 1 week a month for year. School psych. Brought in.
 - 3. Demo taking place at Fenton Academy on Valentine's Day. Ms. Chun cannot make it due to Principals' meeting. Kristin Moss will look into other demo dates.
 - 4. Another idea would have teachers nominate 3-4 students per 3rd,4th,5th grade to be recess leaders.
- vii. Additional AIDES. Currently have 4 aids for each recess. Cost 23k to get an aide for 3 hours for 1 year (1 class) 1 time ask and others would be ongoing to keep up parent survey
- viii. Science Position we have money to cover another year. Will need to have an additional salary increase if 4th grade testing is implemented.
